Introduction

Welcome everyone, I am an interventional neuroradiologist and Chair of the publication Executive Committee at the ESMINT Society. I had the immense pleasure and honor to be chosen as President of the ESMINT 14th annual meeting in Nice this year (2022).

The ESMINT Society is a leading society in the world and its important annual meeting reflects the society's solid engagement in training, education, research, innovation, setting European / International guidelines, and advanced knowledge in our field. Our annual meeting is an important gathering and opportunity to introduce new innovations, advances in our field & the awaited results of important research trials.

Q1. What is new at this year's ESMINT 2022 annual meeting?

I can keep going for hours in my answer to this question as we have introduced many exciting new sessions and additions for our annual meeting this year in Nice! This will give them the opportunity to present their innovations, directly to our community through their booths and a presentation in a dedicated session in the main program. These promising new ideas & innovations will get refined faster through this direct interaction and will have wider exposure and reach. This will also allow practitioners in our field to have the opportunity to know faster about these brilliant ideas and minds. These two combined, will allow faster validation of these new concepts to treat our patients more rapidly and safely.

Another important addition this year is the 'Stroke Development session', we will get to know the current status in the UK, we will hear important

experiences from East Europe and we shall know more about the Angels' initiative. Another extended discussion will be held between experts and our industrial partners about how to overcome the difficulties in setting up stroke networks.

We have another session about emergent Innovative new techniques like endovascular shunting and others. This session will include recorded cases and tips & tricks from experts performing these advanced new therapies.

We will also introduce this year a mobile application, which will make the sessions more interactive by having live polls and direct questions to panel.

Another main objective also this year is to extend the discussion times and interactivity between delegates, speakers & panel.

The sessions of the meting this year will be broadcasted live to expand education and reach of the exceptional scientific content. Our reach this year will reach China through live translation and streaming in Chinese.

Q2. What have you been doing that is new for the trainees, nurses, and technicians?

We have a very exciting program for trainees, the 'ETMINT Session' in parallel to the main session. We focused this year on the ETMINT parallel program and educational activity. The number of faculty and attendees in this session is increasing each year with a very exciting program this year.

ESMINT is a very exciting scientific meeting but at the same time we have this huge luxury that we all love to have fun altogether and to communicate and get to know each other.
